

## What's New?

The following section will discuss all newly added features and improvements that are part of the latest DocuNet 2.1 application release.

Headline	<b>Users can now open manuals in different Tabs.</b>
Detail	<p>As with DocuNet for iOS, users can now open and view manuals in up to 10 different tabs. Each tab will retain its viewing history. Users can also select to open links contained in manual content by holding down or right clicking links and selecting one of the below two options.</p> 

Headline	<b>Users can expand dropdown to quickly navigate between different tabs</b>
Detail	<p>When the amount of tabs exceed the current length of the viewing panel, a dropdown box will be generated to quickly navigate between different manuals. Please refer to the user guide for more information</p>

Headline	<b>Removed Recent History functionality.</b>
Detail	<p>We have removed the “Recent History” function as this has now been replaced with the ability to open manuals in new tabs</p>





Headline	<b>Functionality to disable external links</b>
Detail	<p>Administrators now have the ability to prevent external links from functioning e.g. in an EFB environment. Please contact <a href="mailto:support@vistair.com">support@vistair.com</a> for further information</p>


Headline	<b>Enlarged image pop out when selecting images from manual content</b>
Detail	<p>We have increased the size of images when selected from manual content to utilise as much space as possible for viewing images on various Widows devices.</p>

Headline	<b>Zooming button changes</b>
Detail	<p>The toolbar icons for zooming have been changed for PDF and HTML manuals. The zoom in/out functions are now equivalent to pinch-zooming at the centre of the screen</p>

<b>Headline</b>	<b>Improvements for gesture control for Windows Devices</b>
<b>Detail</b>	<p>We have now made improvements to the gesture control for mobile touch devices. Users can now swipe left or right to go back and forward a page and can also pinch to zoom on pages and image pop outs.</p> <p>The maximum zoom amount has also been increased for a higher quality of viewing when zooming into selected images.</p>

<b>Headline</b>	<b>Delta updates</b>
<b>Detail</b>	<p>We have now changed the way both structured and PDF manuals are updated. If the changes to the manual are less than 75% then DocuNet will only download the updated content instead of downloading the whole manual again. This will improve the speed to update/download manuals by reducing the size of the file needed to download.</p>

<b>Headline</b>	<b>Cosmetic changes to icons for rotate and fit-to-width/height/page</b>
<b>Detail</b>	<p>We have change the icons displayed to rotate and resize the page within the viewing panel.</p> <div style="display: flex; align-items: center;">  <div style="margin-left: 10px;">Fit whole page on screen</div> </div> <div style="display: flex; align-items: center;">  <div style="margin-left: 10px;">Fit page width on screen</div> </div> <div style="display: flex; align-items: center;">  <div style="margin-left: 10px;">Fit page height on screen</div> </div> <div style="display: flex; align-items: center;">  <div style="margin-left: 10px;"> <p>This icon is used to rotate images in the image pop out.</p> <p>Please refer to Windows Viewer User guide 2.1 for more information.</p> </div> </div>

<b>Detail</b>	<p>We have removed the button for “Support Information”. Your local support information is now displayed when opening a new tab with the  button.</p>
