



1) What's New?


The following section will discuss all newly added features that are part of the new DocuNet Viewer for iPad v3.1 application.

Headline	Filtering updates screen and manuals TOC
Detail	<p>You can now filter the list of available updates or installed manuals by typing part or all of the manual title. For example if you only wanted to install or filter "DocuNet" related manuals, you can type "Doc" into the text field and manuals will be filtered as you type. Only filtered results will be downloaded when selecting "Update All".</p> 
Headline	"Restore tabs" prompt removed
Detail	<p>When the app starts you will no longer be prompted to Restore tabs. This will now happen automatically. If you want to restore this prompt you can do so via a "Restore tabs?" switch in the iPad "Settings" under the "DocuNet" app.</p>
Headline	PDF page rotation
Detail	<p>A new feature has been added to rotate pages of PDF manuals. Pages can now be rotated in increments of 90°. Each tab will remember the rotated position of the page. This applies to the currently viewed page only. Select the below icon to rotate the page.</p> 
Headline	Selecting to mark a manual as "Favourite"
Detail	<p>You can now select to mark frequently used or specific manuals as "Favourite". Selecting the star displayed to the left of the manual title will mark the manual as a Favourite.</p> 


Headline	Filter list of installed manuals by “Favourites”
Detail	<p>Once marked as a favourite, you can select to filter the list of all installed manuals by selecting the star displayed at the top of the TOC (pictured below)</p>  <p>The screenshot shows a list of manuals. Headline	“Open with...”
Detail	<p>It is now possible to embed files inside DocuNet documents. These files can be of any type (Word, PDFs, Powerpoint etc). Where applicable, you can open them by clicking on the link inside the document. You will be prompted to choose an installed app that can handle that particular file type and the file will be opened in that app.</p>

Headline	Ability to “Cancel Group”
Detail	<p>Previous functionality allowed you to update manual library by selecting to “Update Group”. We have now added the ability to select to “Cancel Group”.</p>  <p>The screenshot shows a button labeled 'Cancel Group' in blue text on a light gray background.</p>

Headline	PDF Thumbnails are now watermarked with the page number.


Headline	Open Revisions + Notices in new Tabs
Detail	<p>When selecting Revisions / Notices from a manual, you can now hold down on the desired selection and choose to either “open” the selected section or “Open in New Tab”.</p>

Headline	Newly installed/updated manuals will display in yellow.
Detail	<p>Once a manual has been installed or updated, it will appear in the TOC in Yellow as displayed below. This will change back to the original colour (Black) once the manual has been viewed for the first time.</p> 

Headline	Manual information icon
Detail	<p>A new icon has been added, displayed in the top left hand corner of the manual TOC displaying the manual specific details. Manual information included is displayed below.</p> 

Headline	Delta updates
Detail	<p>We have now added the support for Delta updates for both HTML and PDF manuals. This means for any manuals that are less than 75% updated, the device will only download the updated content, instead of re-downloading the entire manual again.</p>

Headline	New registration screen
Detail	<p>The initial registration screen has been updated.</p>

Headline	Air Print
Detail	<p>We have now added the ability to print pages of manuals to compatible “Air Print” devices. Select the below icon to generate the print menu.</p>  <p>Once you have selected the Print icon you will be presented with the below pop out</p>  <p>From here you can select which printer to connect to and also for HTML manuals you can choose what page range you would like to print. For PDF manuals you can only print the currently viewed page.</p>

2) iOS requirements

DocuNet 3.1 has a minimum requirement of iOS 7, although we recommend iOS 8.3 for best results.

Full testing has been completed on iOS 8.3 however we have also completed a regression pack using various other versions of iOS 7 and above.

3) Known issues and limitations

This section discusses key product limitations that may be useful for administration and support. Examples can include any problems that can occur with particular platforms.

The issues listed are under investigation and are scheduled for a future release of the iPad application.

#	Priority	Subject	Workaround
	Medium	There is currently a minor issue with closing the app whilst actively downloading manuals. This can sometimes affect the successful installation of the manual. If the app is closed during a manual download this may require you to restart the download.	<p>We would recommend you wait for the manuals to finish downloading before closing DocuNet.</p> <p>Please note: This does not affect the ability to navigate throughout all other areas of the app while manuals are downloading.</p>

#	Priority	Subject	Workaround
	Trivial	Once the updates screen has been selected in either Landscape or Portrait you will no longer be able to rotate the device to change the view. This is the only screen affected by this minor issue all other screens / pop outs will successfully rotate.	If you navigate to any screen other than the updates screen you will be free to rotate the device and navigate back to the updates screen in the desired view.
